Application for Student Representatives to School Board of Directors

Applications are currently being accepted for Student Representatives to the Board of Directors for the term of August 2018 – June 2020. To be eligible, you must be entering your Junior year in the Anacortes School District in the fall of 2018, and be in good academic standing.

This position is a two-year commitment, to be served during your junior and senior year. Student Representatives are expected to attend all regular Board meetings (generally 2 per month), special meetings/workshops (generally 4-6 per year), and occasional special events, such as conferences or graduations.

Students also prepare an annual report on a topic of their choice, deliver short reports at each board meeting, and may have an opportunity to travel to Olympia to meet with elected officials.

Responsibilities include:

- a. Regular attendance at all board meetings;
- b. Compliance with Board Bylaws and procedures;
- c. Representing the Board at various student events;
- d. Consulting with student councils in the District about issues of Board interest and of concern to students; and
- e. Participating as a representative of the District student body in Board meetings and activities.
- f. Adherence to the Anacortes High School Activities & Athletic Code.

Student Representatives will be full participants in all Board discussions and will be bound by all rules and regulations pertaining to the regular Board members. Student Representatives will not have the right to make motions, vote, or hold Board office, and may attend Executive Sessions only by invitation.

Applications are due by 4:30 p.m. on Friday, April 20th to AHS Principal Jon Ronngren. Interviews will be held in May, and new student representatives will be sworn in at the May 31 evening school board meeting.
